Christmassy clothes and Santa hats may be worn to school on this day.

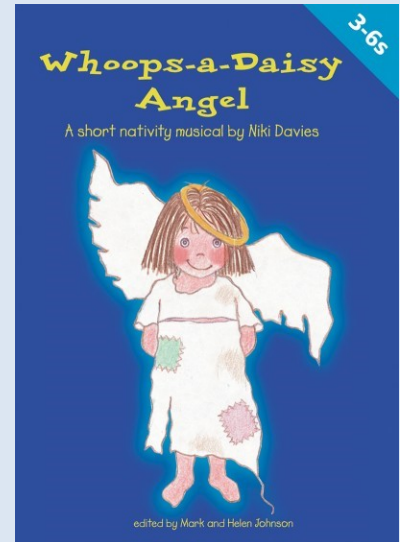
## Whoops a Daisy Angel - Wednesday 15th December
